

GOALIE DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM & EXPECTATIONS



The BHC Development Committee is committed to the recruitment and development of our goalies.

Steve (Spike) Lempelius has joined the Development Committee as our Goalie Development Consultant. In this role, Spike will have ownership for the continued enhancement of our goalie program as well as its execution throughout the season. Spike is passionate about goalie development and is committed to the recruitment and development of all BHC goalies.

The Steve Carroll Goalie School is one of the premier Goalie Development programs in the nation and we are excited to announce a partnership with the BHC. We have formed the partnership specifically for the recruitment and development of all Goalies in the BHC. Steve Carroll and his staff will work directly with Spike in the development of our program as well as provide on and off ice coaching and mentoring to our goalies, parents and coaches.

The following is a summary of our Goalie Development program as well as the expectations for coaches and goalies:

Dedicated Goalie Coaches

Each team will be required to recruit and designate one assistant coach for goalie development. The role of this person is to focus on goalie development during practices and games as well as during the Sunday Night Goalie Clinics provided by the BHC.

Coaching Workshops

Steve Carroll and his staff will perform Goalie Coaching Workshops in the months of October and January. These workshops will focus on teaching the goalie coaches as well as head coaches how to work with and develop the goalies on their teams. Attendance by the dedicated goalie coach and head coach will be required.

Sunday Night Goalie Clinics

Steve Carroll and his staff will provide in season goalie clinics for all goalies in the club. These clinics will focus on skill development. Attendance at these clinics is required by all goalies on your team as well as the dedicated goalie coaches.

Parent and Goalie Meeting

Steve Carroll and his staff will hold one meeting at the start of the season for all goalies and their parents. This meeting will focus on the physical and physiological aspects of the goalie position. Attendance at these clinics is required by all goalies on your team as well as the dedicated goalie coaches.

Off-Ice Training

Steve Carroll and his staff will work with Brandon Steege and develop goalie specific skills for during dry land training. These can be utilized by the goalies while their teams are in the training center.
